- These questions are for Governors to ask Head of School and Senior Leaders. The questions are grouped into three themes, aligned with Ofsted Inspection Criteria
- The answers to these questions should be sent by the Head of School to the LGB 3 days before the meeting (papers for meetings go to the governors 7 days before the meeting)
- The questions below should be assigned to individual Governors and recorded in the meeting

Theme 1: Quality of Education: Curriculum and training (CPD)

- 1. Based on the reviews that have taken place, what are the further areas for development to improve the curriculum? What have learnt this year about the curriculum and what from this learning will you take into planning next year?
- 2. What feedback have you received from pupils about the curriculum they are studying? How will use it to plan for next year?
- 3. What have staff said about the standard of training and CPD to improve the content and teaching of the curriculum, particularly reading? How will you use this information to develop strategies for next year?

Theme 2: Behaviour and Safety and Personal Development

- 1. What have you learnt about the school's rewards programme this year? How will you use this information to develop strategies for next year?
- 2. Based on the data and information you have, how has the curriculum and extra-curricular programme supporting the exemplary character of our pupils?

Theme 3: Leadership and Management

- 1. Based on the recent reviews and the data reports you have from SATs and other testing, How will you use this information to develop strategies for next year?
- 2. Based on the results of the parents' survey, how will you be adapting the school's policy or practice?
- 3. How do you judge the effectiveness of the use of the catch-up funding and sports premium? What have been the lessons you have learnt?
- 4. In reviewing the Pupil Premium Plan update, where do you feel that we can adapt our strategies to accelerate pupil progress and/or pupil attendance next year?
